Light at Deep Lagoon Lane Monument

Martha noted it will cost approximately \$1,500-\$2,000 for new lighting at Deep Lagoon sign. She will present more details later. obtained a quote for bringing electricity to and lighting the Deep Lagoon Monument sign. Because there is no transformer close by, the trenching and conduit costs made it too high to even be considered. As an alternative, commercial solar lighting is being investigated.
